- The scholarship is for \$1000.
- Only two (2) applications will be chosen each year.
- If selected as a finalist, a personal interview may be required.

General Instructions: *Answer all questions to the best of your ability and follow instructions completely. The selection of scholars will be influenced by the completeness of the replies and eligibility regarding requirements.*

Eligibility requirements are:

- You must be a graduating senior from Fremont Ross High School.
- You demonstrate a strong commitment to pursue further education.

Please complete the application as follows:

- Sections 1 through 9 are to be completed by the student applicant and, in Section 9 signed by the applicant and parent or guardian. If the applicant is 18 years of age or older, parent or guardian signature is not required. Be sure information, including email addresses, is correct.
- School counselors will verify accuracy of form submissions.

The following will also be taken into consideration:

- Attendance
- High School activities
- Community activities
- Employment
- Family situation
- Financial need
- GPA (minimum of 2.85/4.0)
- Letter of recommendation
- Possible in person interview
